PERMISSIMA

The Centre Wallonie-Bruxelles / Paris, also known as the Vessel, presents the **2nd edition of PERMISSIMA**, its international live arts festival, which will take place on **Friday, October 24th, 2025**, from noon to midnight, both In-Situ and Hors-Les-Murs.

Prototypical and deliberately undisciplined, PERMISSIMA stands as an invitation to collective experience and is distinguished by its anatomy and non-alignment with standardized temporalities. A feast of forms, this xeno-festival approaches like a rhapsody of impetuous acts, an ode to the live arts in their most unpredictable and audacious forms.

Co-produced with a network of international and cultural institutions, PERMISSIMA sketches a **contemporary transnational trajectory of the plural regimes of performativity**.

Alongside about thirty artists based in Brussels and Wallonia, thirty international artists from 24 countries come together to explore new forms, to speak, do, and act differently.

Utopia is not an escape into the unreal, but the exploration of the objective possibilities of reality and the struggle for their realization, wrote Ernst Bloch.

PERMISSIMA is a call to kinesthetic, visual, and sonic extravagance.

A DISSEMINATING ARCHIPELAGIC FESTIVAL

In 2025, PERMISSIMA goes viral:

To open the festival, a **prefiguration evening** will be held on **Thursday, October 23rd at the Institut Culturel Italien starting at 6:30 PM**. Conceived as a prologue, this evening will offer a preview of the forms that permeate PERMISSIMA. Three performances by Sophia Rodriguez Goldberg (BE/VE), Marija Iva Gocić (RS) & Chloé Sassi (FR) and Emma Saba (IT/CH) with Jeanne Paris (FR) will be presented to project partners, officials, professionals, and the press.

12 HOURS OF PERFORMATIVE EXTRAVAGANCE

Starting at 12:00 PM on Friday, October 24th, as an announcement of an imminent future, **étincelles** will emerge in the urban spaces. A constellation of gestures, situationist performances, non-reproducible acts will bloom in dispersed fragments and will be the proleptic announcement of a program that will unfold from **3:00 PM at the Centre Wallonie-Bruxelles / Paris and at the Centre Culturel de Serbie**.

Inspired by the precepts of civil disobedience and aspirations for deinstitutionalization, these gestures invest the following places:

- **12:00 PM: Le Bicolore – Maison du Danemark**
- **1:00 PM: Beaux-Arts de Paris in the Amphithéâtre d'Honneur**
- **2:00 PM: Atelier Néerlandais**

PERMISSIMA 2 aims to shift and reveal the potential of codified spaces and contribute to the questioning of public spaces as grounds for the unexpected and the non-functional.

From 3:00 PM, the heart of the festival will vibrate within the **Centre Wallonie-Bruxelles / Paris** and the **Centre Culturel de Serbie**, revealing a continuous flow of drama.

70 artists from 24 countries will take over the venues – with iconic pieces and unprecedented creations – in a performative deployment where the boundaries between disciplines intertwine.

Between dances, theaters, experimental music, unclassifiable forms, **PERMISSIMA 2** invites a **parallax view of the world**, a way of thinking through detours, the periphery, the spark.

Far from a simple alignment of shows, the festival offers a **collective, sensory experience**.

Far from constituting a mausoleum that would contribute to the canonisation of the patrimonial heritage of French-speaking Belgian culture, the Centre is a situated catalyst of reference for so-called Belgian contemporary creation and the artistic ecosystem in its transversality.

Through its resolutely desanctuarizing and a-trans-disciplinary programming, the Centre is mandated to disseminate and promote the work of artists based in the Wallonia-Brussels Federation. In this way, it promotes emerging and confirmed talent, from the peripheral to the established. It helps to stimulate international co-productions and partnerships and to focus attention on the Belgian scene.

Each season, the Centre unveils artistic approaches that demonstrate the irreducibility of the porous territories of contemporary creation to a common denominator. Located in the 4th arrondissement of Paris, its programme is spread over more than 1,000 m². A decentralised Belgian vessel, in addition to its In-Situ programming, it also implements off-site programming and invests cyberspace as a territory for creation and propagation with dedicated content.

The Centre is a decentralised department of Wallonia-Brussels International (WBI): an instrument of the international policy pursued by Wallonia, the Wallonia-Brussels Federation and the French Community Commission of the Brussels-Capital Region.

The Centre is a member of the Tram - Paris / Île-de-France contemporary art network and Hacnum - Réseau national des arts hybrides et cultures numériques networks.
